Mayor Hanics called the Meeting of the Common Council of the Borough of Alpha to order at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 26, 2011.

Mayor Hanics announced that adequate notice of the meeting was given to the Star Gazette and posted on the bulletin board in the Clerk's office satisfying the requirements of the Open Public Meeting Act:

Also said notice has been mailed to persons requesting the same.

Mayor Hanics led prayer and the salute to the flag.

*Roll Call:* Present; Councilman Dunwell, Councilman Gara, Councilman Pfefferle, Councilman Savary, and Councilwoman Tarsi. Also present Borough Attorney, Christopher Troxell, Borough Clerk, Laurie A. Barton and CFO, Lorraine Rossetti. Absent: Councilman Zikas.

### Public Comment

Tom Fey, Recycling Coordinator gave his report and stated that a resolution needs to be done for the tonnage grant. Waste Management needs to submit the tonnage report to the Borough and as of yet Mr. Fey has not received it. Mr. Fey also mentioned a poetry contest regarding recycling through the school for grades 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>. He updated Mayor and Council on potential upcoming classes pertaining to certification for recycling coordinator. The classes won't start unless DEP approves the classes.

Louis Cartabona, Fifth Avenue inquired about a pole transformer. Mayor Hanics stated to get the pole number and he can get it reported into the electric company.

## Resolutions:

Motion made by Councilwoman Tarsi to open the public hearing for Resolution 2011-39 regarding the budget, motion seconded by Councilman Savary, all were in favor.

Louis Cartabona, Fifth Avenue, wanted to confirm that the resolution on the agenda tonight regarding the budget, that there would be no increase. CFO, Lorraine Rossetti stated that there is no change in the tax rate.

Mr. Cartabona continued on to commend Council on their hard work putting together this budget.

Motion to close the public hearing on Resolution 2011-39 was made by Councilman Savary and seconded by Councilman Dunwell, all were in favor.

The Mayor turned the meeting briefly over to CFO, Lorraine Rossetti. Ms. Rossetti briefly went through the hand-out she created regarding the breakdown of the 2011 budget.

Motion made by Councilman Pfefferle to adopt the budget, Resolution 2011-39, motion seconded by Councilman Dunwell, Ayes: Dunwell, Pfefferle and Savary. Nays: Gara and Tarsi. Motion failed due to not receiving four affirmative votes.

Discussions ensued regarding why budget was not adopted amongst Council members.

Motion made by Councilwoman Tarsi to introduce Resolution 2011-42 an amendment to

the Budget, motion seconded by Councilman Gara, roll call: Ayes: Gara and Tarsi. Nays:

Dunwell, Pfefferle and Savary. Motion fails.

CFO, Lorraine Rossetti at this time distributed a new resolution to be approved regarding a temporary budget due to the fact of the budget adoption failing. Motion made by Councilwoman Tarsi to approve the following resolution:

#### RESOLUTION 2011-43 ADDITION TO CURRENT FUND TEMPORARY BUDGET

**WHEREAS,** an emergent condition has arisen with respect to the budget adoption process extending past the time for which the Temporary Budget had been prepared and no adequate provision has been made in the 2011 temporary appropriations for the aforesaid purpose, and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency temporary appropriation for the purpose above mentioned, and

*WHEREAS,* the total emergency temporary resolutions adopted in the year 2011 pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 96, P.L. 1951 (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20) including this resolution total \$528,800.00,
