**WHEREAS**, Avenue A located within the Borough of Alpha, County of Warren, State of New Jersey, was previously dedicated for public use; and

Said notices shall be mailed by the Borough Clerk in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40:49-6. The Mayor and Borough Clerk, on behalf of the Borough of Alpha, are hereby authorized to execute any and all instruments and to take any and all steps necessary to effectuate the purposes hereof.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or portions of ordinances which are inconsistent with this Ordinance shall be repealed as to their inconsistencies only. The various parts, sections and clauses of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable so that if any part, sentence, paragraph, section or clause of this Ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalidated by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law

- 4. The agreement shall thereafter automatically be renewed annually for each succeeding fiscal year, provided that such renewal shall not have the effect of extending the period in which any payments are due under any contract entered into for any purchase or services pursuant to this agreement;
- 5. The purchase of any product or service will be in accordance with procedures established by the TCPN and in accordance with the Laws of the State of New Jersey;
- 6. Any payments made pursuant to the agreement will be in accordance with procedures established by the TCPN;
- 7. The agreement may be amended only by a written amendment executed in accordance with procedures established by the TCPN;

8. The agreement may be terminated by either party at any time upon thirty (30) days' written notice by certified mail to the other party to this agreement.

Executive Session-1 Hour and 20 Minutes

Motion made by Councilman Zikas to approve the following resolution:

#### **EXECUTIVE SESSION RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS,** Section 8 of the Open Public Meetings Act, Chapter 231, P.L. 1975, permits the exclusion of the public from a meeting in certain circumstances; and

WHEREAS, this public body is of the opinion that such circumstances presently exist.

- 1. The public shall be excluded from discussion(s) of the hereinafter specified subject matter(s).

- 4. Action may or may not be taken after executive session.
