

# ALPHA BOROUGH 2014 CLEAN-UP SCHEDULE

Residents of Alpha Borough will be allowed to discard household items into containers at:

**Place: INDUSTRIAL PARK**-take Industrial Drive to the end where the salt shed is located.

*(Industrial Drive off of New Brunswick Avenue)*

**DATES: June 13<sup>th</sup> (Fri) & June 14<sup>th</sup> (Sat)**

**TIME: 7:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. (Both days)**

**SENIOR CITIZENS (65 or older)//Physically challenged will be offered CURBSIDE PICK UP on June 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> -Curbside MUST be put out on curb by the evening of June 10<sup>th</sup> - Trucks will only come around once! Curbside pick up: equivalent to one pick-up truck load only**

Call 908-454-0088 Ext.141/Clerk's Office to get on list for Senior Citizen/Disabled curbside pick up. Please call Clerk's Office by Noon on June 10<sup>th</sup> to be added to the curbside list!

Proof of Residency (driver's license or tax/water/sewer bill) will be the only requirement to be able to dump your household bulk items. Access to dump will be limited to **two trips** per household- **Limited to one car or pick-up truckload, per trip**. NO EXCEPTIONS!

**NOTE: The Grass Clipping Area will be closed from June 4<sup>th</sup> until June 15<sup>th</sup>**

**The following items will NOT be accepted for dumping:** liquid waste, flammables, and hazardous waste, including but not limited to computers, monitors and televisions. Clean up trash does not include quantities of tires, masonry, sheetrock, wood/building material, tree stumps or dirt. As of January 1, 2011 the State of NJ has now included computer/monitors/TV on the hazardous waste list. Therefore it can NOT be disposed of in the containers during clean up or in any regular household garbage.
