Public Comment

Mike Savary, Park Ave., discussed the situation in front of his property regarding the sewer line and the trench that was back filled. Mr. Savary contests the bill he was given by the Sewer Engineer, citing that the Borough should have been aware of an existing lateral.

Jim Hill, Frey Engineering explained the billing to Mr. Savary in detail.

Department Reports

Administration, Councilman Peter Pettinelli: No report. Councilman Pettinelli approved all bills, salaries and wages for his department.

Finance, Councilman Michael Schwar: Councilman Schwar reported that the finance clerk volunteered to be named as the COAH housing officer. Councilman Schwar briefly discussed the request to have the finance clerk move her office. A meeting is scheduled with PAIC for Thursday morning at noon to go over the loss survey.
